Track daily weather, temperature, clothing choices and simple observations for one week.

Print-friendly | Original learning content | Adult-guided

1. Keep it short

Use one or two activity pages at a time. Younger learners benefit from short, positive sessions.

2. Read the directions

An adult can read instructions aloud and model the first example when helpful.

3. Encourage thinking

Ask the learner to explain a choice, count aloud, sound out a word, or describe what they notice.

4. Revisit later

Repeat a page after a few days if the skill is still developing. Progress matters more than speed.
